DIRECTIONS:Directions:

From the North or South, NJ Turnpike to EXIT 5. Turn RIGHT onto Route #541 after toll. Take Route 541 towards Mt. Holly. Turn RIGHT onto Mt. Holly BY-PASS (at Burger King) towards Route 38. Go straight across Rt. 38 and at next light turn RIGHT onto Route #541. Follow Rt. 541 south through Lumberton towards Medford. Turn RIGHT after the Bob Bende Soccer Park onto dirt drive.
